4A – Born in 2020 or after

5. A collection of items, displayed in an egg carton

7. Draw a picture of a birthday cake (**Any medium** (oil, acrylic, water colour, pencil, pen, ink, charcoal, etc.))

4B – Born in 2017 or 2018 or 2019

1. Make a birthday cake out of playdough or modeling clay.
2. Create a birthday card for your friend.
3. Make a birthday hat, using items found in your recycling.
4. Paint a picture of your favourite place in Petrolia.
5. Make a colourful and creative necklace to give to a friend.

6. Create art using stones or rocks.
7. Draw a picture of you! (**Any medium** (oil, acrylic, water colour, pencil, pen, ink, charcoal, etc.))

C – Born in 2014 or 2015 or 2016

1. A building in Petrolia, made from Lego(™) - be sure to label it! (no larger than 12”x12”)
2. Draw a picture or make a poster showing your favourite place in Petrolia.
3. Design a birthday card.
4. Make a piece of art using pieces of aluminum foil.
5. Make a birthday gift for your pet using string or yarn.
6. Make a picture using things found in nature (i.e. leaves, sticks, etc.)
7. Make a paper airplane - to be judged on decorations and flying distance
8. Half and half picture (half picture and have drawn)
